Crime Figures For August 01/08/2022-31/08/2022

02/08/2022- Highway Disruption

Caller is reporting that the building site fencing that runs from Neasham Road to the Railway Cottages, has been knocked down. This has resulted in an obstruction on the road as 30 to 40 metal fences have fallen. No officers available to attend, however overnight staff for the building site are due to arrive on duty and will rectify the fencing.

04/08/2022- RTC

Caller reporting that their partner had been involved in a 'hit and run' type incident this afternoon in the Hurworth Place area. Vehicle details were obtained and checked by the call handler. Caller provided a diary appointment to discuss the matter further.

06/08/2022- Theft & Handling

Caller reporting that approx. 10 minutes prior to the call they have witnessed two males riding a scooter/ moped (with no VRM), up the footpath towards Baxby Terrace. Caller thought the vehicle may be stolen and so wanted to contact police. Checks completed which showed the moped was stolen and the owner was aware. Crime submitted, investigation is ongoing.

07/08/2022- Concern/ Collapse/ Injury/ Illness

Caller reporting that they have been in Geneva Woods/ close to the Railway Cottages on Hurworth Moor, when they have heard teenage voices shouting and screaming. Caller was unsure if someone needed help and so wanted to log it with the Police. Officers attended; area search no trace for the teenagers.

07/08/2022- Vehicle Attempt Theft

Caller reporting that two males have attempted to remove the caller's motorbikes from Sanderson Road. No damage has been caused to the bikes however confirmed as vehicle interference. A crime has been logged and is under investigation.
