

Crime Figures for April- 01/04/2022 to 30/04/2022.

02/04/2022- Civil Disputes

Caller is reporting that a customer is refusing to leave the Evans Halshaw Garage, Croft Road. This is due to a delayed payment. Officers attended the garage and spoke to all parties involved. Suspects warned about their conduct during the situation.

02/04/2022- Road Related Offence

Caller reporting that a male has gone into the shop on West End, Hurworth and appears to be drunk. He has then returned to his vehicle and driven away. Initial details taken from caller were incorrect. A further call provided the correct vehicle details. Observations passed to all Darlington Officers and checks completed. Area search, no trace for the vehicle.

03/04/2022- Road Related Offence

Vehicle driving inappropriately seen on Neasham Road/ Hurworth Moor. Traffic Officers were made aware. Vehicle stopped and checks completed. Driver issued with a Traffic 183 for anti-social use.

03/04/2022- Suspicious/ Insecure

Caller reporting that there is a male walking across the fields in Neasham with his dog, which appears to be chasing hares. Caller states there is also a 4x4 parked nearby, however they left the area before details were obtained. Officers attended, area search no trace for the male/ dog or vehicle.

03/04/2022- Highway Disruption

Caller reporting that the traffic lights along Croft Road are not working correctly. Checks done to show Northumbrian Water are responsible for the traffic lights and will get them checked ASAP.

05/04/2022- Highway Disruption

Caller reporting a potentially abandoned vehicle along The Green in Hurworth. Details passed to the Call Handler and the relevant checks were completed. Vehicle not believed to be in the Police interest as all checks were fine.

07/04/2022- Highway Disruption

Caller reporting that there was nearly a collision along Croft Road, due to a driver overtaking on a blind bend. Details were passed to the Call Handler and the relevant checks completed. Observations passed to all Officers and appointment given to the caller who wanted to discuss the matter further.

09/04/2022- Concern/ Collapse/ Injury/ Illness

Caller reporting two youths have been found in the entrance lobby to Rockliffe Hall Hotel. When challenged they stated they were just trying to stay warm. The youths then left the area. Officers in the area did a search, no trace of the youths.

09/04/2022- ASB Environmental

Reports that a small motorbike is being ridden around the grassed/ wooded area surrounding The Grange Association, in Hurworth. Traffic Officers attended the location; however no bikes were present.

11/04/2022- ASB Nuisance

Caller reporting that a group of approximately 8-10 youths have been setting fires in the Geneva Woods area. Request sent for FIRE attendance.

21/04/2022- Vehicle Theft Of

Caller reporting that overnight the bonnet of a car and two headlights have been stolen from the Evans Halshaw garage on Croft Road. The incident has been crimed and is currently under investigation.

24/04/2022- Highway Disruption

Caller reporting that two youths are riding a scooter in and out of traffic on Neasham Road. Officers attended; area search no trace for the youths.

24/04/2022- Highway Disruption

Caller reporting that there are approximately 8 pit bikes travelling from Darlington along Croft Road. Operation Endurance team on duty, therefore Officers attended the area. Four bikes seen in the area however only one stopped, relevant checks completed, and traffic 183 ticket given for manner of driving.

25/04/2022- Road Related Offence

Caller reporting, they have stopped along Neasham road to assist someone that has broken down on a moped, the driver has then admitted they do not have a licence or correct documentation for the bike. Caller has passed details over to the call handler and the relevant checks have been done. Checks showed driver to be fully insured with all the correct paperwork and driver's licence.

27/04/2022- Highway Disruption

Caller reporting there has been a vehicle parked on Hurworth Road for a prolonged period. Details were passed to the call handler and the relevant checks have been done. Vehicle is not in Police interest as all the documentation is correct. Darlington Borough Council have been contacted to remove the vehicle if causing a disruption.

29/04/2022- Road Related Offence

Caller reporting a vehicle for dangerous driving on Roundhill Road. Dash cam footage is available. Caller has been given an appointment for Police to review footage. Details have been passed to the call handler and relevant checks done in order to ask all Officers to keep observations for it.
