

Crime Figures For March 01/03/2022-31/03/2022

01/03/2022 – Suspicious/ Insecure

Caller reporting potential poachers behind their address in Neasham, Darlington. Caller believes the males have arrived via a 4x4 Subaru type vehicle; however, no specific vehicle details have been obtained. Traffic Officers searched the area, no trace of the males/ vehicle.

02/03/2022 – Highway Disruption

Caller reporting that a vehicle has blocked the wheelchair access point going to/ from a property on Linden drive. The vehicle has a flat tyre and so may be there for a prolonged period. Incident has been forwarded to Darlington Borough Council's Civic Enforcement Team for them to progress the situation.

03/03/2022 – Road Related Offence

Caller is reporting that a vehicle travelling along the A66 has been crashing into the barriers and drifting into different lanes. The vehicle details have been passed onto the call handler and the relevant checks have been done. Observations for the vehicle have been given to all Darlington Officers and passed onto North Yorkshire Police, given the direction of travel.

08/03/2022 – Civil Disputes

Caller reporting ongoing issues with builders on Hurworth Road. During the call, the phonenumber has cut off. Officers have attended the property to perform a welfare check and to obtain further details in regards to the incident. CCTV enquiries were also conducted at the scene in order to ascertain further information about the building company.

08/03/2022 – Information

Caller reporting that a silver Mazda is regularly driving around the village of Hurworth at speed and has an incredibly loud exhaust fitted onto the vehicle. NPT aware and will progress.

11/03/2022 – Highway Disruption

Caller reporting that whilst following a vehicle from Neasham Road into Hurworth, they have noticed the male driver is using his mobile; throwing rubbish out of the window and is driving erratically. The vehicle details have been passed to the CH and the relevant checks have been completed. Observations have been passed to all Darlington Officers for the vehicle.

11/03/2022 – RTC Damage Only

Caller has come across a car crash on Roundhill Road, where the vehicle appears to have crashed into a tree and spun out of control. No persons appear to be hurt or still in the vehicle. Officers have attended and waited with the vehicle until it has been recovered.

12/03/2022 – Suspicious/ Insecure

Caller reporting 2x suspicious vehicles parked at Rockcliffe Hall Hotel. No VRMs can be seen due to the position of the vehicles within the car park. Officers attended, no issues. Persons are guests of the hotel.

13/03/2022 – Road Related Offence

Caller reporting that guests at Rockliffe Hotel have become intoxicated and have then left in a vehicle. Vehicle details have been passed to call handlers and the relevant checks have been done. Observations have been passed to all Darlington Officers. Vehicle has been successfully stopped, male driver detained, and vehicle seized.

16/03/2022 – Road Related Offence

Caller reporting that a vehicle is driving at high speed along Hurworth Road to Croft Road. The vehicle details have been passed to the CH and the relevant checks have been done. Officers attended the area, however no trace for the car within the village or at the registered keeper address. NPT aware and will progress.

** There were various ASB incidents involving young children knocking on front doors for addresses within Skerne Park. This included: Calder Avenue and The Lanes. However, due to the placement of the houses they come under the JEO area when searching for incidents/ doing the crime figures. The beat PCSOs for Skerne Park are aware of this and are trying to obtain the IDs for the youths involved. The youths will be warned of their behaviour and any details gathered will be sent to the ASB Team at the Council for progression. **

20/03/2022- Suspicious/ Insecure

Caller reporting that she has seen a male and young child walking in Geneva Woods. The male was carrying a shot gun. Officers made aware, however unable to attend straight away due to the number of other immediate incidents awaiting allocation.

24/03/2022- Vehicle Theft From

Caller reporting that overnight a vehicle has been damaged at the Evans Halshaw garage on Croft Road. The incident has been crimed and is under investigation.

24/03/2022- Criminal Damage

Caller reporting that there has been damage caused to the Golf Course at Blackwell Grange. The incident has been crimed and is under investigation.

24/03/2022- Suspicious/ Insecure

Caller is reporting that 1 hour ago they were walking along Church Row when they saw a male acting suspiciously in the area. Caller was worried they were trying to break into a property or would cause damage. Officers attended the area. No trace of any suspicious persons or damage in the area.

27/03/2022- Highway Disruption

Caller is reporting a vehicle, that is driving in a dangerous manner along Croft Road towards Darlington town centre. Caller is concerned they may be under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Details of the vehicle were passed to the Call Handler and the relevant checks were completed. Observations were passed to all Darlington Officers.

28/03/2022-Road Related Offence

Caller is reporting that there was a near miss between themselves and a vehicle, when out cycling on Roundhill Road. Details of the vehicles involved were passed onto Call Handlers for the relevant checks to be completed. Footage of the incident has been requested from the caller to determine how to progress the situation.

28/03/2022-Highway Disruption

Caller is reporting a vehicle that is causing nuisance in Hurworth. They regularly speed through the village and are believed to have forged paperwork, including MOT certificates. Relevant checks have been completed for the vehicle and further action will be taken by the Neighbourhood Policing Team.

29/03/2022- Theft & Handling

Caller is reporting that two unknown males in an unknown vehicle have pulled into Blackthorn Drive and stolen caller's milk from their front door. Caller wanted the Police to know in case there are numerous reports. Incident has been crimed and is under investigation.

29/03/2022- Council/ Civil Dispute

Caller reporting that travellers have parked up on the Dinsdale Golf Course land. Darlington Borough Council made aware of the situation and advice given to landowner. Neighbourhood Policing Team are also engaging with the landowner in regards to this situation.

31/03/2022- Burglary Business/ Community

Caller reporting that the Croft and District Working Men's Club has been broken into and their cash register has been stolen. Officers attended the incident and CSI were deployed. The incident has been crimed and is currently under investigation.

The Children's Home on Hurworth Road was also broken into, however no items believed to be stolen. Incident crimed as criminal damage.
