

TREE CARVING PROJECT AT THE GRANGE

There are lessons for people who wish to learn and create art works in the form of wood carvings.

There is an ongoing project at present, to enhance the tree stump tree at the Grange next to the playground area.

The pictures above show what sort of thing can be expected once the work is complete.

Whilst the actual tree itself is not being carved directly, this is due to the tree being a beech tree and to carve intricate details directly into it would be very difficult, due to its makeup.

Wood has been purchased for the door, which is being carved separately. A hollow would then be cut out in the tree, allowing this false door to be inlaid into it. The same applies to the other features.
