

Crime Figures for May- 01/05/2022 to 31/05/2022

01/05/2022- ASB Nuisance

Caller reporting that there are 9 young adults trespassing on the golf course at Blackwell Grange. Officers attended; area search no trace. Members of the public stated the youths left the area towards South Park. Officers also attended this area, however still no trace of the youths.

02/05/2022- Highway Disruption

Caller reporting that there is a black/ tan terrier type dog running loose on the A66 in between the Evans Halshaw garage and the Rugby Stadium. Officers attended; area search no trace.

02/05/2022- Burglary Residential

Caller reporting on behalf of the resident. Caller reporting that the property on Snipe Lane has been broken into as the front window has been damaged. Items have also been stolen from within the property. The incident has been crimed and is currently under investigation.

03/05/2022- Highway Disruption

Caller is reporting that a deer has been hit on the A66 between the stadium and Morrisons. The deer is deceased however drivers are struggling to avoid it in the middle of the road. Street Cleaning for Darlington Borough Council has been contacted and will attend to remove the deer.

Caller reporting that in the last few minutes they have seen three young males on bikes. The caller doesn't believe them to be local and felt uneasy as they were hovering around the Church View area. Traffic officers attended; no youths/ bikes were found.
