1. Hurworth Grange Country Fair Committee reserves the right to make corrections and additions to the Terms and

Conditions as and when necessary. Please check www.hurworthgrange.com for updates.

2. Disabled badge holders and their drivers may park in the school's staff car park. Onsite parking is limited to wheelchair users and walking frame users only.

3. No exhibitor car parking is allowed at the Grange, or on site on show day.

4. Onsite and offsite (behind Hurworth Comprehensive School) car parking arrangements will be signposted and marshalled.

5. Anyone can enter an exhibit in to the Hurworth Grange Country Fair Craft and Produce Show; you do not have to live in Hurworth/ Hurworth Place. All entries are anonymous.

6. For the Tallest Sunflower Competition (categories 41 to 42) sunflowers can either be grown in a pot, or directly in the garden. Judging will be held in the contestant's own garden on **Thursday 15th September** at a pre-arranged time. Trophy for the tallest sunflower, in each category, can either be collected from the Hurworth Grange Office after the show closes on 17th September, or it can be awarded as part of the presentation detailed in section 21 – please advise the Hurworth Grange Office accordingly.

7. Photographs, paintings, handicrafts and flower arrangements should be brought to the Hadwin Lounge, Hurworth Grange for set up between **4pm and 7pm on Friday 16th September**. Exhibitors can also set up between **7:30am and 9:30am on Saturday 17th September**.

8. At 9:45am the Show Hall will be closed to exhibitors and the public for the duration of Judging. The Show Hall will re-open to exhibitors and the public once Judging is complete.

9. All exhibits must remain on show until after the presentations and collected after 4pm.

10. Perishable exhibits left after 5pm will be disposed of.

11. Other exhibits will be held for 48 hours at the owner's risk and afterwards disposed of at the Committee's discretion.

12. With the exception of flower arranging classes 23 to 25, all exhibits MUST have been grown, sewn, painted, created, or made by the named exhibitor's own efforts.

13. The exhibitor's name must not be visible on any exhibit.

14. An exhibit previously placed first, in any show or fair, may not be entered in to the Hurworth Grange Craft and Produce Show.

15. Photos entered in classes 55 to 58 must have been taken by a person aged 16 or under on 31st August 2021 and have date of birth entered on the back of each photograph.
16. In all photography classes: Photos should be no larger than paper size A5 and mounted on stiff white card. NOTHING must be removed or added to the picture.
17. Failure to abide by these Terms and Conditions will result in confiscation of trophies and cash prizes and exclusion from future Hurworth Grange Craft and Produce Shows.
18. The Judges' decision is final.
19. Best in Section Rosettes awarded in each section (excluding the Tallest Sunflower Competition).
20. Cash prizes (£3 for 1st, £2 for 2nd and £1 for 3rd place) will be awarded in each section (excluding the Tallest Sunflower Competition) and can be collected from 1:30pm at the Administration Desk (Hurworth Grange Office) – please show your exhibitor's ticket when collecting.
21. All trophies and prizes will be presented at 3pm in the main show arena.
22. Trophies, shields and cups for any of the adult categories are awarded for one year only and must be returned to the Grange Community Centre office 2 weeks before show day the following year. These remain the property of Hurworth Community Association at all times.
23. All trophies awarded in any of the under 16 age categories can be retained by the exhibitor.
24. The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry and return fees without explanation: they reserve the power to cancel any class with fewer than three entrants.
25. The Committee do not accept responsibility for any loss or damage to produce or personal property during the time they are on show: all entries are received subject to this condition.
26. Each exhibitor is limited to 2 exhibits per category.
27. Show entry forms and fees (50 pence per exhibit entered) can be registered at the following times:

Monday 12th September 2pm to 4pm (Grange Office) and 6pm to 8pm (Grange Office/ Bar)

Tuesday 13th September 2pm to 4pm (Grange Office) and 6pm to 8pm (Grange Office/ Bar)

Wednesday 14th September 2pm to 4pm (Grange Office) and 6pm to 8pm (Grange Office/ Bar)

NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED.

28. The submission of a registration form and entry fee will be deemed confirmation that the Hurworth Grange Country Fair Terms and Conditions have been accepted.
29. The Hurworth Grange Country Fair raffle is open to all mainland Great Britain residents over the age of 16 (this excludes Northern Ireland, Isle of Man and Channel Islands). The tickets may not be sold to, or by a person under 16 years of age. If a ticket is sold unknowingly to a person under the age of 16, they will be exempt from the raffle and will forfeit their prize.
30. All tickets must be paid for before being included in the raffle draw.
31. Hurworth Grange Fair Committee take no responsibility for any lost raffle tickets.

32. All raffle prizes will be presented at 3pm in the main show arena. Any prize winners who are unable to collect at this time will be contacted by phone to make arrangements to collect their prize from the Grange.

33. Any raffle prizes not collected within 7 working days of the Hurworth Grange Country Fair will be donated to following Hurworth Grange events.

34. The raffle prizes are non-transferable and no alternatives will be provided.

35. The result of the Raffle draw is final.
